 A fine modern Vinho Verde, with aromas of apple and grapefruit. The palate is medium-bodied and refreshing, with the classic touch of spritz.

 Aromatic and interesting Portuguese field blend.
22. **Sauvignon Blanc Coopers Creek Marlborough, New Zealand bottle**

 This is absolutely classic Marlborough Sauvignon: vibrant gooseberry, passionfruit and nectarine backed with hints of herbaceousness.
23. **Sancerre La Croix du Roy Loire Valley, France bottle** **£46**
 Pure, fruity and crisp on the palate. Good length and classic mineral flavours. The home of Sauv Blanc.
24. **Carneros Chardonnay Sainsbury California, United States bottle**

Expressive California Chardonnay, with tropical and citrus fruit backed up with a hint of barrel-derived spice. Vibrant yet structured on the palate, made in an elegant, food-friendly style.

25. Condrieu Rhône, France bottle

26. Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Les Embrazées Burgundy, France bottle

This vineyard gives a refined, focused style of Chassagne; medium-bodied, with green apple fruit and aromas of hazelnut and green tea, finishing with true premier cru power, yet sleek and linear.

27. Pratello Lugana Lombardy, Italy bottle

A real hidden gem of a wine, with vineyards overlooking Lake Garda. The local Verdicchio grape offers purity and freshness.

29. Babylon's Peak Shiraz/Carignan Swartland, South Africa

30. Conde Valdemar Rioja Crianza Spain

34. Fleurie Clos des Quatre Vents, Beaujolais Cru France bottle

Full-bodied for Fleurie, with plenty of oomph to match the trademark floral character, and complex savoury fruit.

35. Tormaresca NéPriCa Puglia, Italy bottle

A soft and balanced Primitivo with juicy ripe dark fruit.

36. Julicher Estate 99 Rows Pinot Noir Martinborough, New Zealand bottle

£51

Complex and aromatic Pinot Noir with spicy, mineral aromas over berry fruit. Balanced and juicy on the palate, with real expression of place, and a long, vibrant finish.

37. Prunus Dão Tinto Portugal bottle

Silky and crammed with mulberries, blackberries and anise. Portuguese field blend.

38. Quercus Cabernet Merlot, Gorizia Slovenia bottle

£28

Fruity bouquet of blackcurrant, strawberry bush and plum, leading to a smooth, full-bodied flavour.

39. Château Cissac, Haut-Medoc Bordeaux, France bottle

£45

Very reliable claret with dark fruits and cedar, delicious!

40. Ferraton Côtes-du-Rhône, France bottle

£36

Deep dark fruit and spice, a classic!

41. **Mon Roc Rouge**, France bottle

A soft and easy red from the South of France.

42. **Nuits-Saint-Georges Vieilles Vignes** Burgundy, France

Sleek, aromatic burgundy with the typical blackberry and spice character of Nuits. Beautifully poised, this wine shows the depth and precision that comes from old vines.

43. **Masi, Riserva di Costasera Amarone della Valpolicella Classico** Italy bottle

Plums and baked cherries on the nose with hints of bay leaf. Magnificently rich and soft on the palate with rich cherry and blueberry flavours and some sweet spice. Long, dry finish.

44. **Chateau Grand-Puy-Lacoste, Pauillac** Bordeaux, France bottle

Over performing fifth growth, capturing the magical blend of cassis, pencil lead and measured power.

45. **Antinori Peppoli Chianti Classico** Tuscany, Italy bottle

A really top Chianti from this noble estate, cherry fruit and earthy tones.

46. **Château Jolys Cuvée Jean Jurancon** France

Lusciously rich with a nose of exotic fruits and flowers. Powerful, smooth and elegant.

47. **Ferreira White Port** Douro, Portugal

Full of flavour, nutty, crisp and dry.

48. **Ferreira Quinta do Porto 10 Year Old Tawny** Douro, Portugal

Excellent balance of ripe fresh fruit and the dried fruit and spice from extended ageing.

49. **Tokaji 5 Puttonyos Sauska**, Hungary bottle

An exceptional Tokaji, opulently flavoured yet still so fresh and youthful, with aromas of fig, honey, dried peach, marmalade and caramel. Intense sweetness is balanced by brilliant citrusy acidity.
