## Sparkling & Champagne

1. Champagne Ruinart Blanc de Blancs France bottle £95  
Iconic, classic & elegant. Clean, with bright citrus.
2. Champagne Drappier Carte d'Or Brut France 125ml £16<sup>50</sup> / ½ bottle £35 / bottle £65  
This 8th generation, family owned champagne house are the leading environmentalists in the region. Their champagne is superb! Pinot Noir based, with great concentration of flavour.
3. Viticoltori Acquesi, Rosé, Brut Piedmont, Italy 125ml £9<sup>50</sup> / bottle £35  
Pink Nebbiolo. Light and dry, with summer fruit flavours.
4. Prosecco di Valdobbiadene Extra Dry Italy 125ml £11<sup>50</sup> / bottle £45  
A delightful Prosecco: soft textured, clean as a whistle, with apple fruit, floral notes and a delicate finish.
5. Cottonworth Classic Cuvée Hampshire England bottle £56  
A Refined, creamy sparkling Brut that offers a brilliant balance between chalky, fruity/floral and yeasty, bread notes.
6. Champagne Drappier Brut Nature Zero Dosage, France bottle £79  
A blanc de noirs of compelling purity, this champagne is elegant and bone dry, with delicate mineral and lemon notes. The lowest levels of sugar and sulphur in any Champagne.
7. Champagne Perrier Jouet Belle Epoque France bottle £150  
Among the finest prestige cuvees in the world. Perfect balance of freshness and silky floral notes.

## Rosé Wine

8. Terre del Noce Pinot Grigio Rosé Italy 175ml £9 / bottle £29  
A crisp, blush style rosé from Veneto. Pale and refreshing.
9. Château Minuty Côtes de Provence Rosé St Tropez, France 175ml £10 / bottle £40  
This delightful rosé really captures Provence, with apricot and floral nuances. Dry yet generous, it shows excellent balance and texture.
10. Château D' Esclans Rock Angel Provence France bottle £55  
The palest of pale pinks, this delicate rosé offers a core of pretty stone fruit with some herbal notes and an elegant, mineral finish.
11. Tormaresca Calafuria Rosé Salento, Italy bottle £41  
The bestselling Rosé in Italy, a little darker, dry and full of crunchy watermelon flavours.

## White Wine

12. Castel Firmian, Pinot Grigio Mezzacorona Trentino, Italy 175ml £10 / bottle £32  
Very clean, with great balance, floral aromas, good medium weight in the mouth, and a refreshing finish.
13. Jean-Marc Brocard Chablis France 175ml £14 / bottle £45  
Precise nose, pure and mineral, with notes of citrus. Classic Chablis: structured, crisp and delicious.
14. Conde Valdemar Rioja Blanco Spain 175ml £9<sup>50</sup> / bottle £29  
Fresh, intense aromas of fruits and white flowers, dominated by apple and pear.
15. Touraine Sauvignon Blanc, Dom. du Haut Perron Loire, France 175ml £10<sup>50</sup> / bottle £34  
A fresh, grassy nose is followed by a palate full of green apple and citrus fruit.
16. Viognier Vin de Pays d'Oc, France 175ml £9<sup>50</sup> / bottle £29  
Bursting with Viognier character: apricots, peaches and preserved citrus fruit. Smooth and fresh.
17. Organic Passo Blanco, Masi Tupungato, Argentina bottle £29  
A blend of Pinot Grigio and Torrontés in this aromatic white - orange blossom, grapefruit and peach.
18. Blanc de l'Observatoire, Château Ksara Lebanon bottle £33  
Lebanon is better known for its reds but we love this blend of indigenous and international grape varieties. Floral, soft and elegant
19. Castello della Sala, Conte della Vipera Umbria, Italy bottle £48  
Antinori's take on the classic white bordeaux blend, expressive Sauvignon and zesty Semillon.
20. Picpoul de Pinet Beauvignac Languedoc, France bottle £32  
Elegant aromas of citrus, pear and white flowers, and a crisp, mineral palate. A real seaside favourite.
21. Broglia Gavi di Gavi La Meirana Piedmont, Italy ½ bottle £21 / bottle £45  
Great texture and precision, with almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, particularly characterful.
22. Serra da Estrela Albariño Galicia, Spain bottle £33  
One of the most exciting varieties coming out of Spain, lemon peel all the way.
23. Vinho Verde Anjos de Portugal Quinta da Lixa, Portugal bottle £29  
Fine and modern, with aromas of apple and grapefruit. Medium-bodied and refreshing, with a touch of spritz.
24. Prunus Dão Branco Portugal bottle £29  
Aromatic and interesting Portuguese field blend.
25. Riesling Calcaires Jaunes, Muré Alsace, France bottle £42  
Dry, Rich and elegant on the palate, with a streak of lime freshness and mineral finish.
26. Sauvignon Blanc Coopers Creek Marlborough, New Zealand bottle £39  
Vibrant gooseberry, passionfruit and nectarine backed with hints of herbaceousness.
27. Sancerre La Croix du Roy Loire Valley, France bottle £48  
Pure, fruity and crisp on the palate. Good length and classic mineral flavours. The home of Sauv Blanc.
28. Carneros Chardonnay Buena Vista California, United States bottle £59  
Expressive California Chardonnay, with tropical and citrus fruit backed up with a hint of barrel-derived spice. Vibrant yet structured on the palate, made in an elegant, food-friendly style.
29. Condrieu Rhône, France bottle £72  
Fresh, concentrated ripe stone fruits and a hint of honey. The home of Viognier!
30. Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Les Embrazées Burgundy, France bottle £79  
Medium-bodied, with green apple fruit and aromas of hazelnut and green tea, sleek and linear.
31. Pratello Lugana Lombardy, Italy bottle £39  
A real gem of a wine, with vineyards overlooking Lake Garda. The local grape offers purity and freshness.
32. Mon Roc Blanc France bottle £24  
South of France dry blend, crisp and refreshing.
33. Chablis La Boissonneuse, Julien Brocard France bottle £58  
A spectacular Chablis that punches way above its weight in terms of complexity and depth. With vivid aroma of honey, candied peel and warm stones.

## Red Wine

34. Babylon's Peak Shiraz/Carignan Swartland, South Africa 175ml £9<sup>50</sup> / bottle £30  
Mocha and chocolate with dark berry flavours are complemented by spicy undertones.
35. Conde Valdemar Rioja Crianza Spain 175ml £10 / bottle £37  
Complex aromas of ripe black berries balanced with warm vanilla notes and a touch of subtle spice.
36. Domaine la Prade Merlot Côtes de Thongue, France 175ml £9 / bottle £29  
A smooth, spicy Merlot with aromas of plums, berries and tobacco.
37. Castel Firmian Pinot Noir Mezzacorona, Italy 175ml £11 / bottle £35  
Fresh, light and crunchy Pinot from the Dolomite mountains in the North of Italy
38. Norton Malbec Coleccion Finca La Colonia Argentina 175ml £11 / bottle £35  
Deep red colour with violet hues. Aromas of ripe red fruit, cassis and black pepper. Elegant and smooth with a long finish.
39. Fleurie Clos des Quatre Vents, Beaujolais Cru France bottle £37  
Full-bodied for Fleurie, with plenty of oomph to match the trademark floral character, and complex savoury fruit.
40. Tormaresca NéPriCa Puglia, Italy bottle £31  
A soft and balanced Primitivo with juicy ripe dark fruit.
41. Organic Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Umani Ronchi Italy bottle £33  
Plentiful fresh red berries lead onto pleasing herbal flavours and subtle notes of spice from the oak.
42. Prunus Dão Tinto Portugal bottle £32  
Silky and crammed with mulberries, blackberries and anise. Portuguese field blend.
43. Château Ksara Reserve de Couvert Rouge Lebanon bottle £35  
From the oldest and largest producer in Lebanon with a prime location in the Bekaa Valley. This Bordeaux blend is smooth and round, with a complex depth of flavour.
44. Château Cissac, Haut-Medoc Bordeaux, France bottle £42  
Very reliable claret with dark fruits and cedar, delicious!
45. Côtes-du-Rhône, Domaine de Bearenard, France bottle £39  
Juicy red fruits and purity of flavour.
46. Mon Roc Rouge, France bottle £24  
A soft and easy red from the South of France.
47. Nuits-Saint-Georges Vieilles Vignes Burgundy, France ½ bottle £42 / bottle £79  
Sleek, aromatic burgundy with the typical blackberry and spice character of Nuits. Beautifully poised, this wine shows the depth and precision that comes from old vines.
48. Masi, Riserva di Costasera Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Italy bottle £80  
Plums and baked cherries on the nose with hints of bay leaf. Magnificently rich and soft on the palate with rich cherry and blueberry flavours and some sweet spice. Long, dry finish.
49. Chateau Grand-Puy-Lacoste, Pauillac Bordeaux, France bottle £110  
Over performing fifth growth, capturing the magical blend of cassis, pencil lead and measured power.
50. Antinori Peppoli Chianti Classico Tuscany, Italy bottle £47  
A really top Chianti from this noble estate, cherry fruit and earthy tones.

## Dessert Wine

51. Château Jolys Cuvée Jean Jurancon France 50ml £4.<sup>50</sup> / 100ml £9 / ½ bottle £28  
Lusciously rich with a nose of exotic fruits and flowers. Powerful, smooth and elegant.
52. Ferreira White Port Douro, Portugal 50ml £5 / bottle £32  
Full of flavour, nutty, crisp and dry.
53. Ferreira Quinta do Porto 10 Year Old Tawny Douro, Portugal 50ml £5.<sup>50</sup> / bottle £45  
Excellent balance of ripe fresh fruit and the dried fruit and spice from extended ageing.
54. Tokaj Oremus Late Harvest Hungary bottle £59  
An exceptional Tokaji, opulently flavoured yet still so fresh and youthful, with aromas of fig, honey, dried peach, marmalade and caramel. Intense sweetness is balanced by brilliant citrusy acidity.
